### **Bible Study Concepts and Tools**

#### *Degree of Certainty*

A correct posture of Bible study and right theology is humility. One way to practice humility while engaging in Bible study is to use the Degree of Certainty scale, a scale standing for degrees of how certain or uncertain one might be on any given concept. While a handful of Scriptures are absolute and should be stood on with an “I will die on this hill” attitude, most doctrine as we’ve come to understand it, as well as most theology requires a humble approach that dwells somewhere in the middle of the degree of certainty scale, rather than on one pole or the other.
